



Statement of Responsibility for the Structures Study Committee

The Structures Study Committee will serve as an ad hoc committee appointed by the President of the SELCO/SELS Board of Directors. The initial duration of their responsibilities will be from February 2007 through June 2008, as outlined in the proposed timeline for the SELCO/SELS Structure Study. With input, the committee's mission and scope of responsibility may be amended as the Structures Study proceeds. http://www.selco.info/about/structure_study_timeline_2.pdf.

Committee membership will consist of the elected members of the Executive Committee and additional members of the Board of Directors representing a variety of organizational interests. The staff Structures Team will serve in a support capacity.

Responsibilities of the Structure Study Committee may include such tasks as:

- Review and contribute to information gathered during environmental scan
- Review organizational data
- Explore alternative organizational structures
- Solicit input from library staff and trustees of SELCO and SELS member libraries and, as warranted, outside sources
- Participate, as appropriate, in the statewide structures study
- Make recommendations concerning the future of the regional library structure addressing the needs of the member libraries
- Identify and guide a sound implementation process if any changes are proposed
- Communicate regularly with the SELCO/SELS Board of Directors and member libraries.
